ORDER APPROVING DISPOSITION OF 2004 PORSCHE 911 TURBO CABRIOLET

This case came before the Court for hearing on March 26, 2012 upon the Receiver's Motion for Approval of Disposition of 2004 Porsche 911 Turbo Cabriolet (the "**Motion**"). Having reviewed the Motion, heard argument, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, the Court finds that the sale of the 2004 Porsche 911 Turbo Cabriolet is in the best interest of the Receivership Estate and is necessary for the adequate protection of the rights of the parties. Accordingly, it is ORDERED and ADJUDGED that:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.

2. The Receiver is authorized to employ Mecum Auctions, 950 Greenlee St., Marengo, Illinois, to sell the 2004 Porsche 911 Turbo Cabriolet, VIN No. WP0CB29934S675579 described in the Motion for a commission of 7% of the sales price with a \$750 registration fee.
